## **Basic Function of Position**

The intern will assist with updating PAS and Pol/Econ lists of contacts with accurate, up-to-date information. S/he will conduct research projects on political and economic data and trends in our four state district (Jalisco, Nayarit, Colima, and Aguascalientes). Incumbent will also assist with the administration of our press and social media outreach as well as cultural and education programs. The intern will perform other routine office tasks as needed.

## **Qualifications**

Note: All applicants must address each selection criterion detailed below with specific and comprehensive information supporting each criterion:

- Applicants must be enrolled in a post-secondary school pursuing a university degree in Politics, Economics, or Communications.
- The incumbent of this position must be extremely organized and have excellent follow through. Must also have a very can-do, positive and solution-oriented demeanor.
- A good working knowledge of English (speak/read/write) is highly desirable.
- Proficient use of Microsoft Office (Outlook, Word, Excel) and Internet browsing computer programs.

#### Minimum Eligibility criteria

- Only Mexican Nationals attending local universities are eligible. Students must have at least one year remaining on their school program to apply for the position.
- Eligible students must meet the definition of a student as follows:

"An individual who is enrolled not less than half-time in a trade school, technical or vocational institute, junior college, college, university or comparable recognized educational institution. All

Foreign National Student Intern Program applicants must have graduated from high school or equivalent secondary school prior to beginning the internship."

### <u>Mission's requirements for Mexican Student Interns:</u>

- -Minimum age: Intern Program applicants must be at least 18 years of age at the time of application
- -The student must be in good academic standing at their current educational institution. A minimum GPA of 8.0 is required.
- -The student must receive a security certification from the Regional Security Office (RSO).
- -The student must be covered by his/her own medical insurance, and must receive a medical clearance for employment from a certified physician (cost is the applicant's responsibility).
