PEAV is a program that allows a student from a partner institution enroll in one or more online credit courses offered by our institution (Courses catalogue PEAV 2021-A).

In the PEAV program, all partner institutions with a collaboration agreement will enjoy exemption from the cost of registration.

Due to the nature of virtual learning, not all courses can be offered in a virtual way or are suitable for hosting international students in a virtual exchange program.

- 4. Language certificate (in the case of students from non-Spanish-speaking countries).
